The **Iowa DNR Mobile Education Exhibit** will be at Hy-Vee on **Wednesday, April 13th from 11:30 am - 1:30 pm** Stop by the exhibit to see how your waste and habits affect the land in Iowa. This is an EARLY OUT DAY!

A free drop off of your e-cycling products and appliances will be available on **Saturday, April 16th from 9:00 am - 4:00 pm** at the Brush Facility. **Used televisions, computers and other electronics and appliances will be accepted for recycling free of charge.**
